

Canadian Navigable Waters Act



The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated hereby gives notice that an application has been made to the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* for approval of the works described herein and their sites and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act, The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Research (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry numbers **10036** and **10271** or under the NPP File Number 2024-311849 a description of the following works, their sites and plans:

- Bridge (Repairs)
- Cofferdam (Temporary)
- Embankment (Temporary)
- Dyke (Temporary)
- Platform (Temporary)

in and over the St. Lawrence River (La Prairie Basin) at 45° 28' 31.83»N, 73° 32' 28.5»W, between lots 5 636 289 and 1 380 621 in the Quebec Land Register, city of Montreal (Verdun District), province of Quebec.
