




Winter operations – Winter 2020-2021



- + December 18, 2020 to March 18, 2021
- + Operations 7 days a week, from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- Preventive maintenance from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.: to minimize closures during peak hours
- + Path and sidewalk were open 96.3% of the time
- + Closures communicated to subscribers (by email or over Twitter)
- + Expected operating costs: **\$295,000**
- Overall traffic is: 14 036: 6987 by bicycle (49%) and 7049 by foot (51%)





Priorities for JCCBI

+ Effectively manage risks:

- Provide a safe cycling surface despite changing conditions along the route
- Monitor weather conditions
- Operation and maintenance costs
- + Ensure that pedestrians, runners and cyclists can all use the path safely in the winter
- + Communicate effectively with users about:
 - Any closure due to weather conditions or snow removal operations
 - Conditions on the path and sidewalk





User responsibilities

Adopt safe behaviour: +

- Wear a helmet
- Have winter tires and a good lighting system •
- **Slow down** on slippery roads
- **Slow** down, or even stop, when approaching or crossing other users
- Follow the Highway Safety Code

Adapt to the conditions of the path or sidewalk:

- Pavement may be more slippery (black ice, freezing rain) ٠
- Path is even narrower in the winter
- Steep slopes (approx. 4%) and tight curves
- Path and sidewalk exposed to high winds and humidity



Winter signage





In addition, variable message signs at the path and sidewalk entrances indicating conditions:

Green – Be careful, welcome

Yellow – Snow cover, snow cover in areas, reduced width, icy areas

Red – Path closed, maintenance in progress, patch closed at 10 p.m.

























Communication with Users


