

Completed, Ongoing and Upcoming Work


Steel and painting work 2020-2021



Montreal sector

Work types:


- + Gussets / diagonals
- + Bottom chords
- Removal of metal rivets / bolting operations
- Cleaning and painting
- + End of work in residential zone in May 2021
- Start-up of work zone
 (between Érié and Viger Streets)



Steel and painting work 2021-2024



Montreal sector



Work will continue until 2024 but will be carried out over the river away from residential areas



Health and mitigation measures



- + Sound level meters on site: to comply with standards, : sound level meter
- + Acoustic barriers: to reduce noise range
- Occasional local traffic hindrances: to ensure the safety of users and workers
- + Flaggers on site when required
- + Work from **Monday to Saturday**, 7:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- + Contractor start-up times: 7:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m.
- + Health measures strictly followed: physical distancing of 2 metres, masks and visors



Installation of kick rail plates



Multipurpose path and sidewalk

- Protect the traffic lanes under the bridge from falling objects and ice
- Work completed in December2020
- + Installation of snow fences from fall to spring to prevent snow from being thrown from the path and sidewalk during snow removal operations






Land Redevelopment under the Bridge



Work sequence






- + 2020: Zones F, G and H, between De Lorimier and Falardeau and Érié = finished Planting to take place in 2021 (Zone E = Contractor start-up site)
- + 2021: Zones B, C, D and E, between De Maisonneuve East, De Lorimier and Falardeau = in progress (scheduled end date: in mid-October)




















Work sequence





- + 2020: Zones F, G and H, between De Lorimier and Falardeau and Érié = finished Planting to take place in 2021 (Zone E = Contractor start-up site)
- + 2021: Zones B, C, D and E, between De Maisonneuve East, De Lorimier and Falardeau = in progress (scheduled end date: in mid-October)



Ongoing work – Schedule



- + Work from Monday to Saturday (occasional), 7:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
 - Contractor **start-up time:** between 7:00 a.m. and 7:30 a.m.
 - Work start: 7:30 a.m.
- + Sundays and public holidays: work suspended, with some exceptions
- + Note that the schedule may change depending on how the work progresses and on weather conditions





Disruptions minimized for residents



- + This work will generate **noise** (transportation of materials)
 - Sound level meters on site: to ensure compliance with current standards
- The contractor has been made
 aware of the neighbourhood
- + Occasional local traffic hindrances during the work: to ensure resident and worker safety



 Notices of violation (\$) will be issued to contractors who start before the permitted time





Partner Community Organizations





- An NPO that helps organizations better co-exist with vulnerable and marginalized people
- + A JCCBI partner for many years, Spectre de rue helps our teams perform work on the land under the bridge while minimizing impacts to the community
- + One resource assigned to this area
- Voluntary and egalitarian approach
- + Meets immediate needs
- Very positive results



Coop Les Valoristes

- JCCBI partner since 2014
- + Social economy enterprise that buys returnable beverage containers from people having trouble entering the traditional job market. It sells the containers to Recyc-Québec
- + The Coop collected 1.5 million cans in 2020
- + JCCBI has made the land available free of charge since the first temporary storage site was set up under the bridge
- + On-site Mondays and Tuesdays from May 24 to October 8, 2021
