


## IIII Steel work 2019-2020





#### IIII Ongoing steel work (Montreal sector)

- + Contractor: Stellaire
- + Work supervision: WST Consortium
- + Start-up of work zone
  (between Érié and Viger)
- + Acoustic enclosures will be set up
- + Work types
  - Gussets / diagonals
  - Bottom chords
  - Removal of metal rivets / bolting operations
  - Cleaning and painting
- Holidays: Work will stop from December 23, 2019 to January 3, 2020
- + End of work schedule for July 2021

## IIII Planned concrete work (ongoing)

- Contractor: Dimco
- Work supervision: WST Consortium
- Start-up of work zone
  - Between René-Lévesque and De Maisonneuve
- Work types:
  - Repairs to pedestals
- Mitigation measures
  - Installation of an acoustic wall (between De Maisonneuve and Campion, and between Tansley and René-Lévesque)
  - Work hours changed to between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. (between Tansley and Falardeau)
- The site will be rehabilitated with a drainage trench (on Falardeau)
- Site take-down: November 2019





#### IIII Concrete work (start: mid-March 2020)

- Planned work
  - Repairs to pedestals south of René-Lévesque
  - Sandblasting and surface coatings on all pedestals
  - Repairs to two masonry piers on Sainte-Catherine
- Traffic Hindrances
  - Partial closure of the left-hand lane on René-Lévesque
- Mitigation measures
  - Installation of an acoustic wall (between De Maisonneuve and Campion, and between Tansley and René-Lévesque)
  - Installation of sound level meters
  - Work schedule: 7:30 a.m. start
- Scheduled end date: July 2020



## IIII Archaeological digs



#### **Near the Jacques Cartier Bridge**

- + Areas with high archaeological potential
- + Research carried out in different lots
- Previous digs: discovery of a site of a white-clay pipe factory of the BANNERMAN/MONTRE brand
- + These digs are complete



## IIII Wonderful discoveries!

- + 2019: Discovery of a pipe kiln from the Henderson factory and some clay pipes
- + These digs are complete



#### IIII Drainage and land redevelopment



 Temporary drainage solution in place







#### IIII Drainage and land redevelopment

- + The redevelopment proposed in 2017 is currently being reviewed
  - The Ville de Montréal's public consultations are finished, and JCCBI took part in these consultations
- + Preparatory work by Énergir planned for spring 2020
- + JCCBI's work could begin in summer 2020



## IIII Homelessness and Spectre de rue




#### **Effective intervention**

## IIII Multipurpose path

#### Simulation of winter operation (2019-2020)

- + JCCBI is looking to:
  - Refine maintenance, surveillance and communication protocols
  - Determine the most effective snow removal techniques and deicing products
- + Group of 25 test cyclists
- The RTL VéloBus will be available for all cyclists this winter
