Launch a research and development competition

For researchers,

To improve the durability of its structures, The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) want to take the opportunity of deconstructing the Champlain bridge to carry out a research and development program based on certain elements of the existing bridge via a Competition.

The present procurement notice which is addressed to any party interested in submitting a project, provides information on the timeline of the project.

After the analysis of the results of the survey of interest, JCCBI will launch a competition at the latest during the third week of June in order to select the research projects. Interested parties have four (4) weeks to fill the forms and submit their project proposals.

The process is structured to meet best practices and to ensure an open, fair and transparent treatment to respondents under the supervision of a fairness monitor. The documents of the competition will be accessible via private market « MERX » at <http://www.merx.com/pjcci>, at a cost directly payable to MERX. A specific communication will be held at the time of launch of the competition. The objective of JCCBI is to announce the projects selected for its research and development program in September 2019.

The deconstruction of the Champlain bridge is a unique opportunity in terms of research and development which will benefit not only JCCBI but the entire ecosystem and the scientific community.
